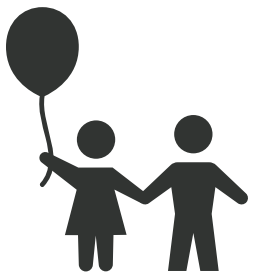
HISTORY

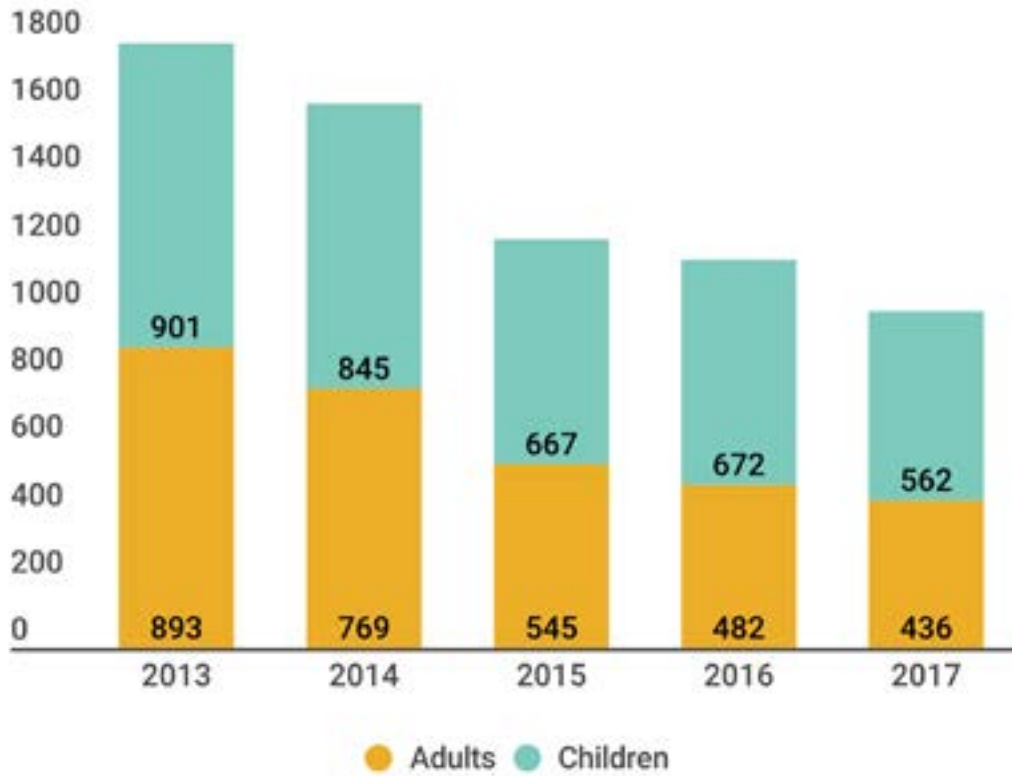
Gateway180's vision to end family homelessness in the St. Louis community is only possible with a wide network of partners and resources working together.

Persons Served

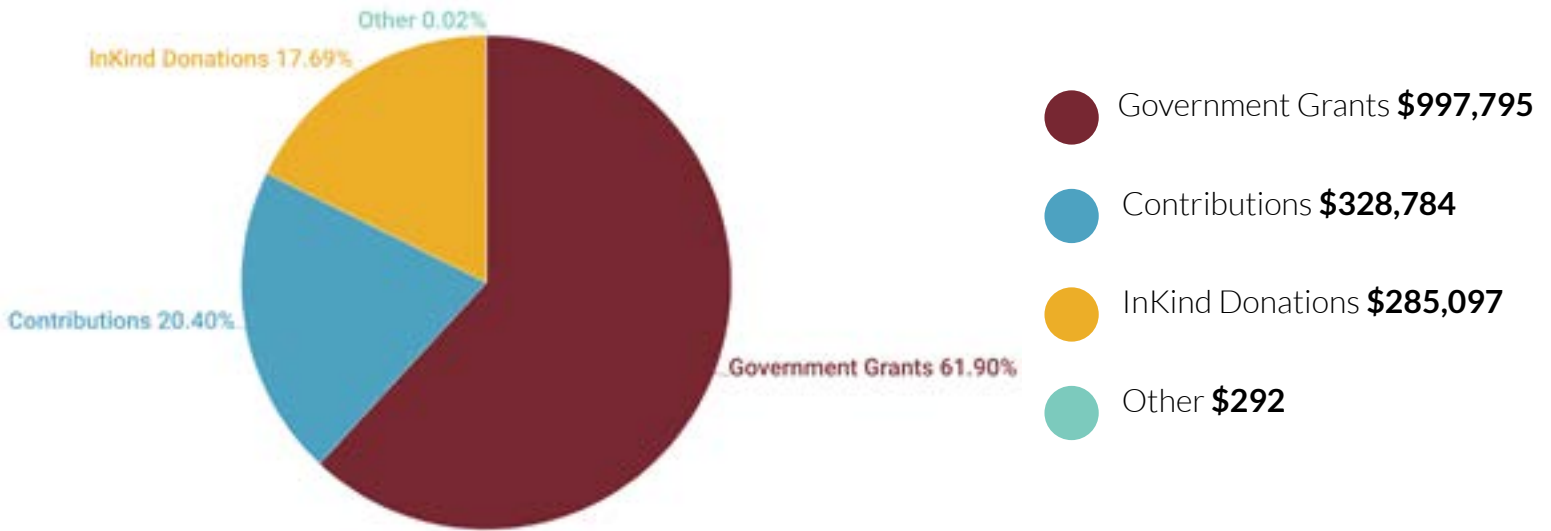


Amount of Persons Placed in Housing

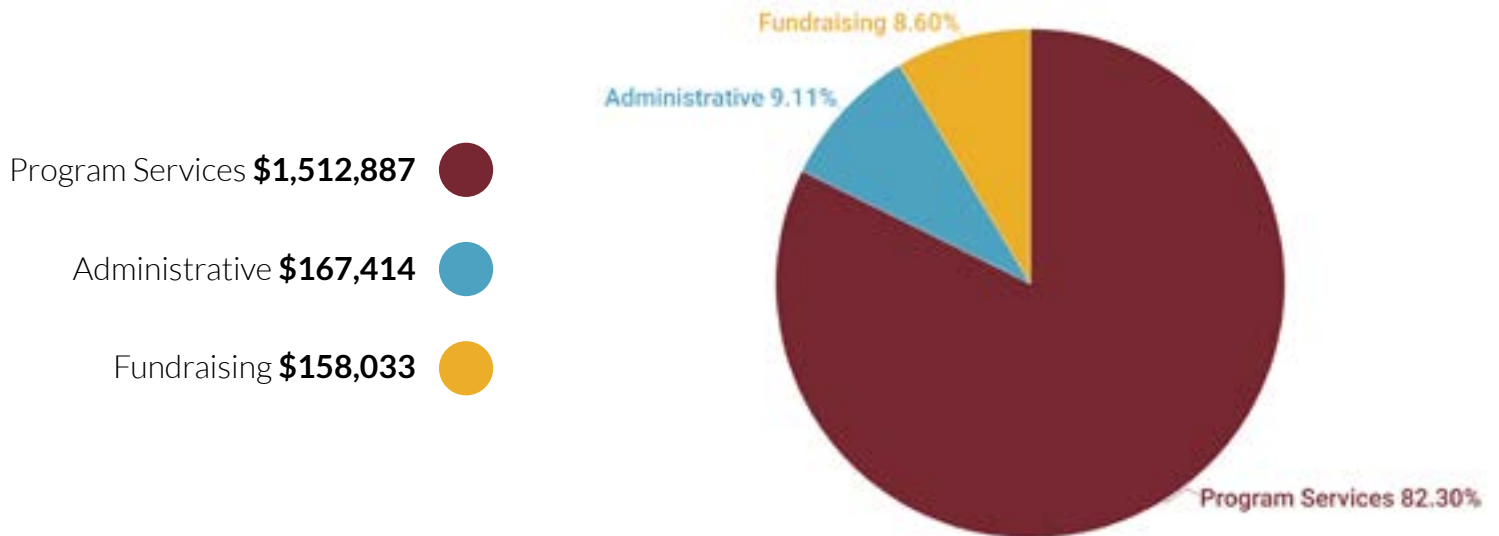




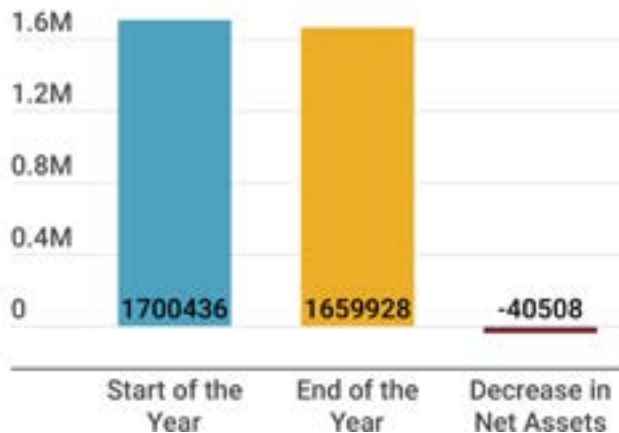
2017 Operation Revenues

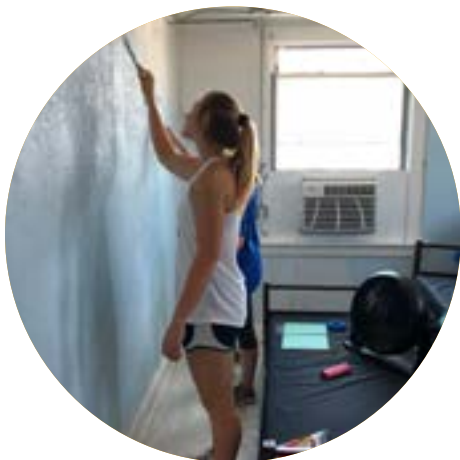
2017 Volunteers and InKind Donors

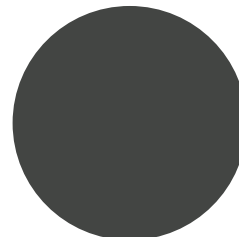
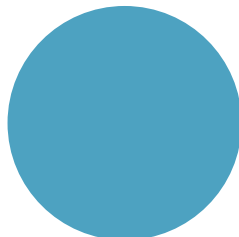
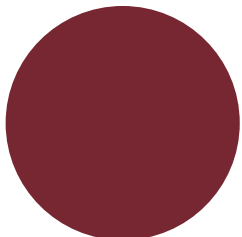
