
In 2017, we served 999 clients, 56% of whom were children.




Gateway 180 relies on people for their gifts of time, treasure, and talent, and we make sure we're good stewards of these gifts that are shared with us.



## **Persons Served**




## **Amount of Persons Placed in Housing**







## 2017 Operation Revenues


