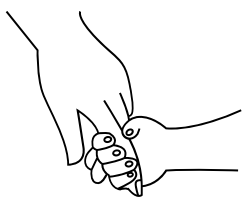
HISTORY

Founded in 1977, Gateway180's Mission is to empower adults and families to become independent and permanently housed.



FAMILY MATTERS

Gateway180, the largest residential emergency shelter in Missouri, prioritizes keeping families together by welcoming all family members, including teenage boys and fathers.



CHILDREN ARE THE FUTURE

In 2024 alone, Gateway180 assisted 424 clients experiencing homelessness, including 212 children. Each number represents a real family and a child who deserves safety and stability.

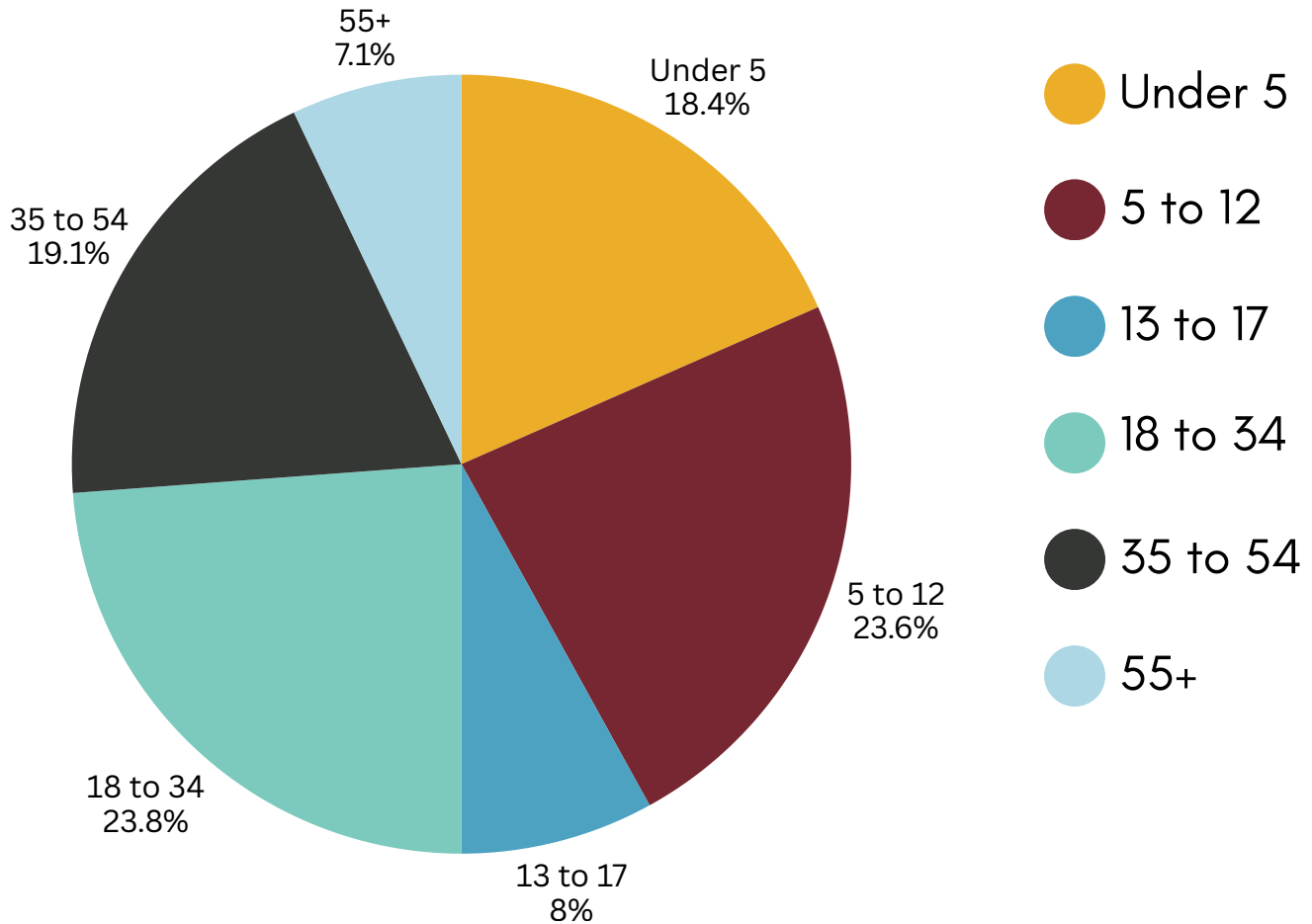

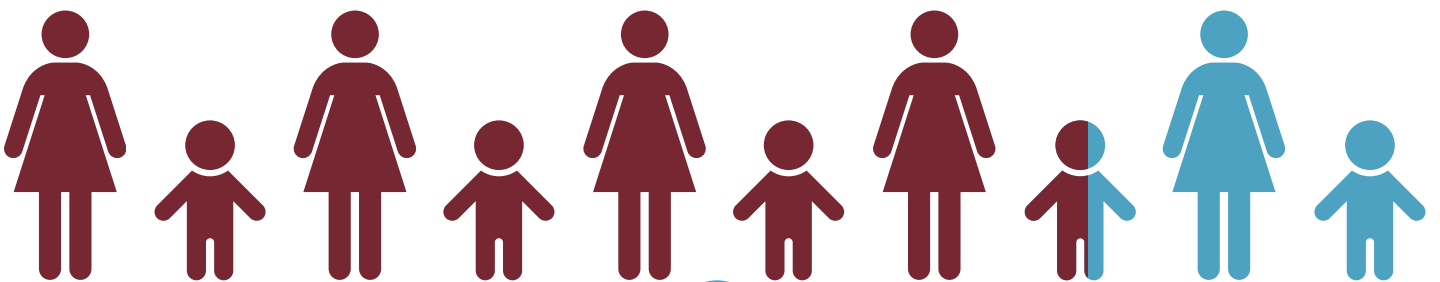
Individuals Served by Age



Gateway180 proudly provided housing and services to 15 veterans along with their spouses and/or children in 2024.

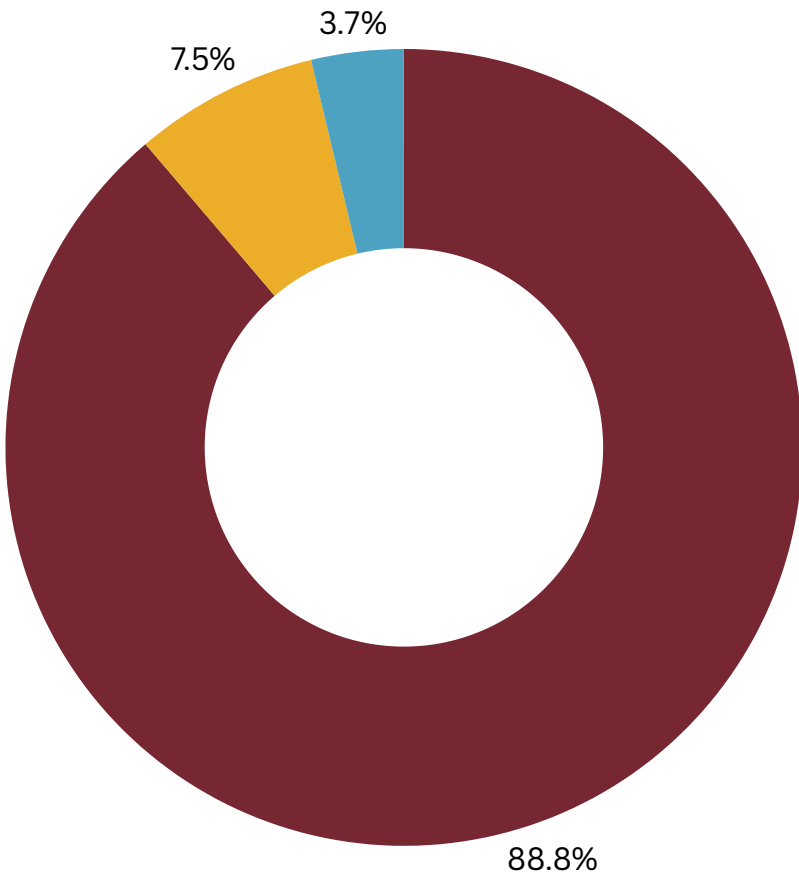
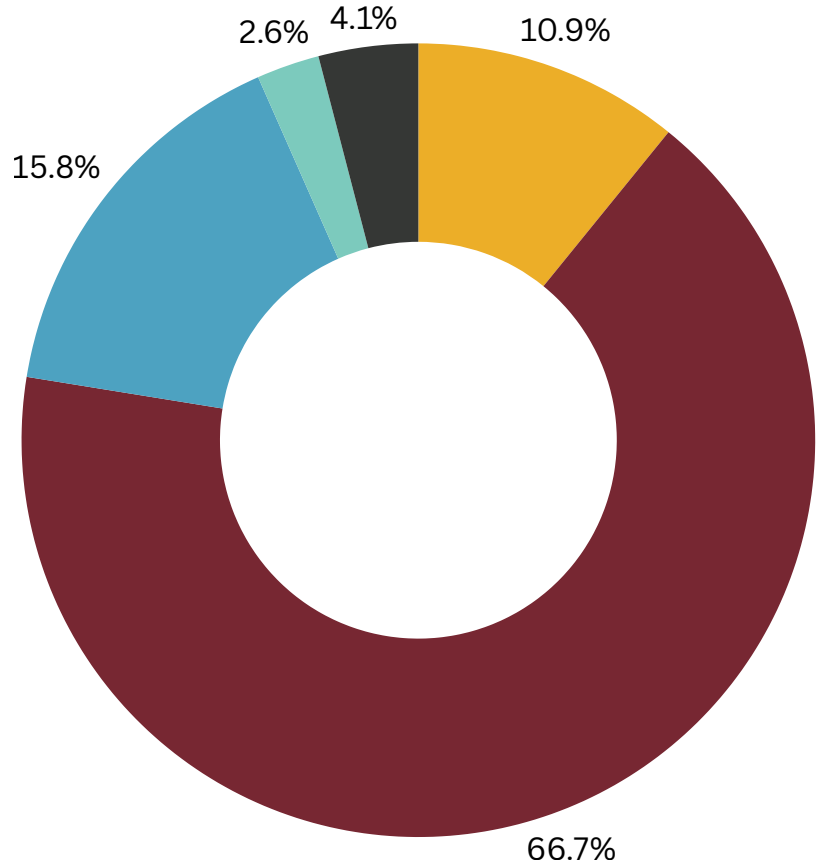
Out of the 424 individuals served, 249 or 59% successfully found independence and moved into permanent housing.

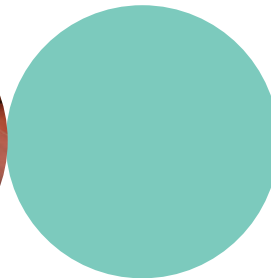
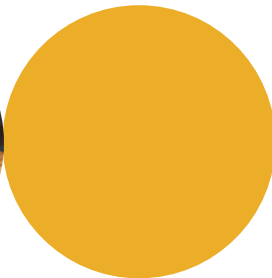
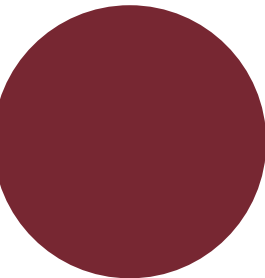
